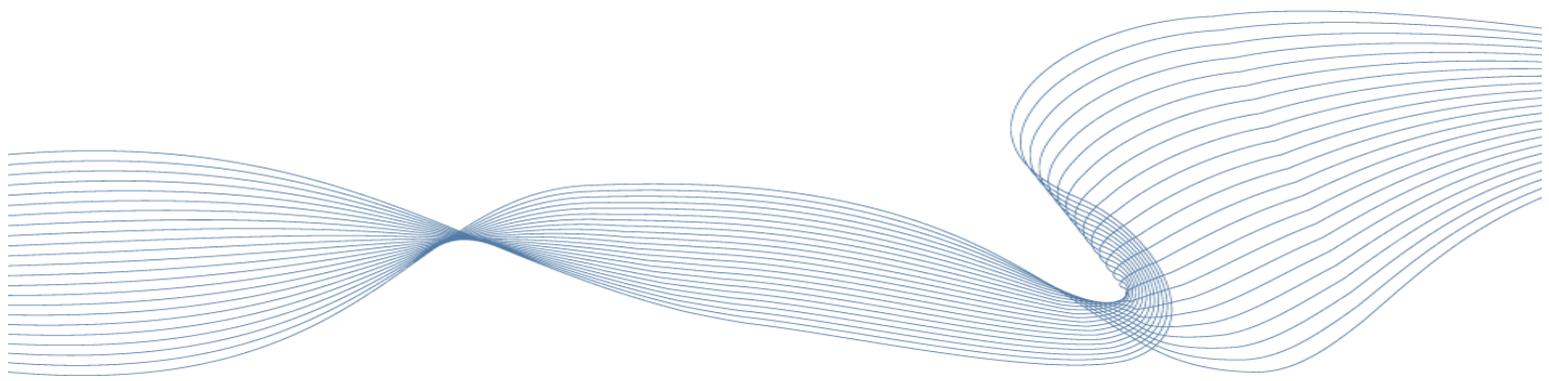


Structure of the SITSI[®] program
